Brief Reasons, if any:

I wish to ensure that the parties are on track for the trial to commence in October 2026.

As I understand it, on May 14, 2020, San Fillipo J. ordered that the trial be bifurcated into Phase 1 (determination of liability on all claims advanced) and Phase 2 (determination of remedies and the crossclaims). On January 24, 2022, San Fillipo J. directed the parties to exchange lists of issues to be adjudicated at trial. The parties appeared to agree that further expert reports should be exchanged before the parties finalized the lists of issues. I would appreciate receiving an update on the status of the issues list as they must be finalized in the near future.

I ask the parties to proceed as follows:

1. On or before noon on October 31, 2025, the plaintiff shall advise whether it believes the lists of issues have been finalized. If so, I ask the plaintiff to deliver a list of the agreed upon issues. If not, I ask the plaintiff to deliver its current proposed list of issues.
2. On or before November 7, 2025, I ask each defendant and intervener to advise whether it believes that the list of issues have been finalized. If so, I ask them to deliver a list of the agreed upon issues. If not, I ask each defendant to:
 - a. provide its list of proposed issues; and
 - b. indicate without argument whether it agrees or disagrees that each issue identified by the plaintiff is to be adjudicated at trial.

Once I have received these responses, I will provide a further direction on next steps.
