- (b) fixing an extended date for the delivery by the Defendants of their statements of defence and dates for other pre-trial steps such as for the affidavit or certified list of documents to be produced and for examinations for discovery; and
- (c) leave for the hearing of this motion at Brantford;

ON READING the Amended Motion Record for this motion which had been adjourned on consent to May 25, 1995 after being originally returnable on April 19, 1995, and on hearing the submissions of counsel for all parties to the action,

1. THIS COURT ORDERS that leave be granted for the hearing of the motion at Brantford.

THIS COURT ORDERS that each of the Defendants deliver their statements of defence no later than June 30, 1995 subject only to any further order that might be made by this Court before that date to extend the time pursuant to a motion returnable before this Court at the Court House in Brantford before June 30, 1995.

3. THIS COURT ORDERS that a decision on the balance of the motion is reserved, to be the subject of a further order.

4. THIS COURT ORDERS that the costs relating to this motion are reserved to the ultimate disposition of this motion.
